Study Abroad Fast Facts:

- With proper planning, every student at Fairfield University has the opportunity to study abroad.
- Students have the opportunity to participate in a credit bearing international internship with career coaching and post program support. *Locations where internships are available include: France, Spain, Italy, Ireland, England, and Australia!* Internships are mandatory in some locations
- Students are expected to enroll in a minimum of 15 credits at an appropriate level of instruction for at least 4 days per week, and are expected to enroll in 1-2 major or minor courses, 1-2 core courses, and 1-2 elective course for each term abroad.
- When studying abroad for a semester/year in a country where the native language is not English, students are required to take a language or language and culture course.

MARION PECKHAM EGAN SCHOOL OF NURSING AND HEALTH STUDIES: PREFERRED PROGRAMS

Semester:

- James Cook University: Townsville, Australia Nursing (Fall Semester Junior Year*)
 - Students studying abroad in Australia will be abroad from July-November and will enroll in a prescribed curriculum. Students will take NURS2272 prior to departure (lecture only) and will fulfill the 80 clinical placement hours at Townsville Hospital in Australia. Fall term begins in late July and concludes in late November.
- University of Galway: Galway, Ireland Nursing (Spring Semester Junior Year*)
 - o Students studying abroad in Galway will enroll in a semi-prescribed curriculum at the University for a total of 15 credits. The module on International Nursing (NU230) requires students spend time in the clinical setting. This gives students an opportunity to observe nursing practice in Ireland first hand. Students are placed in University College Hospital, Galway for these hours.

Short-Term Faculty Led Programs: Each Year Several Faculty create courses that use the location as a living textbook! Check out the <u>Faculty Led section of the website</u> to see what is being offered! Some regular offerings are seen below.

- Public Health Nursing in Puerto Rico (Fall Break, Spring Break)
 - o Students collaborate with students from **Universidad Sagrado Corazon** and community leaders to address health problems. This experience fulfills the required public health clinical hours. Students need to commit to group meetings prior to the Spring Break Session.
- Lourdes Pilgrimage Order of Malta American Association
 - o The Order of Malta is a lay religious order of the Catholic Church which serves the sick and the poor. Each year, The American Association of The Order join over 20,000 Pilgrims [Knights, Dames, physicians, nurses, Malades (French for "The sick"), and their caregivers] on a Pilgrimage to Lourdes, France. We are honored to offer two scholarships to student nurses from Fairfield University, who have completed their Junior year. The Lourdes Pilgrimage Scholarship is being sponsored by: Joseph F. Berardino '72, Former University Trustee, and Gail T. Berardino, School Of Nursing Advisory Board Member.

SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING: PREFERRED PROGRAMS

Semester:

- The University of Galway: Galway, Ireland (*Fall Semester Junior Year*)
 - o Students studying abroad with University of Galway will enroll in a semi-prescribed curriculum at the University for a total of 15 credits. **Mechanical and Biomedical Engineering Majors are invited to join this program.**
 - o Fairfield University also offers **Biomedical Engineering** majors the 4+1 pathway opportunity for graduate study with University of Galway. The Biomedical Engineering Master's program is completed within one year and provide graduates with a degree from a globally ranked university for internationally competitive careers.
- Instituto Químic de Sarrià (IQS): Barcelona, Spain (Spring Semester Junior Year)
 - o IQS has a strong relationship and association with science and business/industry. This provides great flexibility, dynamism, and constant evolution through innovation and adaptation to academic and social reality. Students will enroll in a semi-prescribed curriculum at the University for a total of 15 credits. Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Majors are invited to join this program.

Summer: ICAM: Vannes, France: Icam's Summer Program, in the amazing setting of Vannes, France on the Morbihan Gulf, combines theoretical concepts and technical skills with a focus on energy transition and sustainability. Students complete the program with the design and creation of a complex, technical solution. Program content includes Materials Science – Thermal Transfer, group projects in Icam's Fablab (maker lab), and exposure to French language and culture.

SUMMER & SHORT-TERM PROGRAMS FOR ALL STUDENTS

Short Term Summer programs can take students to an archeological dig site in Greece, all the way to the Coral Reef of Australia! Global Fairfield offers more than 30 locations abroad during the summer months where students can earn 3 to 6 credits.
