



COVID 19 PREVENTION POLICIES IN PROGRAM HOUSING

Shared Responsibilities



HOUSEMATES ARE CONSIDERED A FAMILY UNIT

You will share your housing and living experience in Florence. Each one of you is responsible for the collective health and safety of your household. No guests are allowed



WASH OR DISINFECT HANDS

When you enter and exit the apartment
Before you cook or enter the kitchen
Before and after bathroom use
Before and after entering common space



MONITOR YOUR TEMPERATURE DAILY

If your temperature is 37.5 or higher

- self isolate
- contact a medical professional
- notify your program staff



IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS

Including a fever, cough or difficulty breathing, do not attend class or leave your home, self isolate, contact a medical professional and notify your program staff.



IN THE KITCHEN

Wear a mask if you are with others in the kitchen.
Wash pots, pans, dishes, glasses immediately after use.
Wipe down all surfaces with wipes or disinfectant sprays.



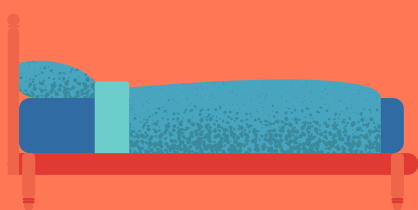
CLEANING

Wipe down high touch surfaces daily.

Clean bathroom and kitchen surfaces after use.

Wash bed linens weekly

Agree with your housmates on a weekly cleaning schedule and shared duties for common spaces and deep cleaning.



PLEASE DON'T MOVE BEDS

All furniture has been placed to allow for social distancing. Please don't move or rearrange furniture.



OPEN YOUR WINDOWS

Air out your apartment for at least an hour each day.

If it is particularly cold, you can open up windows several times each day for 10-15 minutes.



REMOVE SHOES UPON ENTERING APARTMENT

Consider removing your shoes and changing into slippers or indoor shoes to help keep the apartment clean and germ free.



DISPOSE OF YOUR OWN TRASH

Trash needs to be taken out on a daily basis. You might want to take turns with taking out the recycling but each housemate should dispose of their personal trash (i.e: personal hygiene products, tissues).
